Regional Competitive Events

General Guidelines

Participant Eligibility for Region Level Competition

- Participants can compete in up to two (2) events at the regional level. Participants may have their two (2) events be with performance.
- Oregon FBLA will not institute limits to the number of competitors a chapter can register for each competitive event – Chapters can register an unlimited number of members per event

State Level Qualification / Eligibility

- Participants can compete in up to two (2) events. Participants may have their two (2) events be with performance.
- Chapter Events do not count towards the two (2) event limit per participant
- The top 10 winners at the regional level will be recognized and receive awards and are qualifiers for state level competitions

Competitor Conduct

Any participants found to be sharing event topics, scenarios, or test questions with any other person (including guests, advisers, chaperones, members from other schools) will be disqualified from ALL competitions. Depending on the severity, the participant may be removed from the conference or in certain cases the entire chapter may be disqualified from competition.

Please take note of these important guidelines and expectations for competitive events:

- **Objective Testing for Role Play Events:** With the exception of Client Service and Impromptu Speaking, all role play competitors must take the objective test.
 - For teams, all members of the team must take the individual objective test. If a team member does not take the test, they will be removed from the team and not allowed to perform in the final round.
 - The top 15 scoring entries in Role Play Events objective testing will perform in the final round at RSC.
- **Complete all components of competitive events:** Please note that the following competitions have multiple components for overall scoring. All components must be completed to be eligible to place in the event:
 - Business Ethics
 - Case Study
 - Objective Test
 - Performance (Case Study and Objective Test must be completed/submitted by January 16th in order to perform)
 - Job Interview
 - Resume & Cover Letter (These pre-judged documents must be completed/submitted by January 16th in order to interview)
 - Interview
 - All Production Events
(Computer Applications, Database Design & Applications, Spreadsheet Applications, Word Processing)
 - Objective Test (Completed by January 16th)
 - Production Test (Submitted by January 16th)
